- V. CONSENT AGENDA
 - A. APPROVAL OF FINANCIAL REPORTS.

Alderman Burch made a motion to move this item to the Deliberation Agenda. Alderman Swaim seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-2 (Aldermen Wrinkle and Oberg were the NO votes).

VI. MAYOR'S REPORT

- Saturday, October 3, 2015 will be the next vaccination clinic.
- Tuesday, October 6, 2016 will be National Night Out at City Hall.
- There will be a possible sewer rate increase. We still have to talk to Azle regarding the increase.

Alderman Oberg made a motion to approve Ordinance #232 setting the 2015-2016 General Fund and Enterprise Fund budgets. Alderman Swaim seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-2 (Aldermen Wrinkle and Burch were the NO votes).

D. REVIEW, DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO APPROVE ORDINANCE #233 SETTING THE 2015 PROPERTY TAX RATE, WHICH WILL REMAIN THE SAME.

Alderman Swaim made a motion to approve Ordinance #233 setting the 2015 Property Tax Rate, which will remain the same. Alderman Shumate seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-2 (Aldermen Wrinkle and Burch were the NO votes).
