

RESOLUTION NO. 11

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
PELICAN BAY, RECOMMENDING THE TEXAS WATER
COMMISSION GRANT THE APPLICATION OF JACK HUDSON
FOR PERMIT NO. 13105-01 FOR DISPOSAL OF
SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT EFFLUENT

WHEREAS, the City of Pelican Bay recognizes that sewage treatment services are needed and beneficial to the public health, safety, and general welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Application of Jack Hudson for Permit No. 13105-01 is currently pending before the Texas Water Commission; and

WHEREAS, granting of Permit No. 13105-01 would be beneficial to the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Pelican Bay, in that the City of Pelican Bay would be able to utilize the proposed facility for sewage treatment; and


WHEREAS, the City of Pelican Bay expects, at a later date, capacity expansion to include all of the City of Pelican Bay; and
