

RESOLUTION NO. 14

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR A CONTRACT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF PELICAN BAY AND JAYBIRD KENNELS OF SPRINGTOWN, TEXAS; PROVIDING FOR THE CARE AND ELIMINATION OF UNCLAIMED CANINES; PROVIDING FOR A METHOD OF PAYMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF PELICAN BAY, TEXAS.

I.

WHEREAS. the City of Pelican Bay is entering into agreement with Jaybird Kennels of Springtown, Texas, to providing food and care for canines that have been picked up by the City's Animal Control Officer.

II.

The City will be responsible for transportation and delivery of canines to the kennels and the transportation and delivery of any returned canines to their owners.

III.

Jaybird Kennels will be responsible for providing food and water for canines left in their care and will not release any animals to anyone except the City's Animal Control Officer. Canines will be keep for a period of 72 hours (3 days).

IV.

Any canines left unclaimed beyond the 72 hours will be destroyed, in a humane manner, by Jaybird Kennels or if a proper home can be arranged by the kennel owners, the canine may be adopted. The City shall only be charged for the initial 72 hours, in any case.


V.

The City will maintain sufficient records to determine, on a monthly basis, the total cost to the City and the charges will be payable on the first of each month.

VI.

This resolution shall become effective from and after its passage and approval by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Pelican Bay.
