

RESOLUTION 259

WHEREAS, on March 26, 2020, the Mayor issued a Second Amended Declaration of Local Disaster Due to Public Health Emergency for the City of Pelican Bay, Texas resulting from evidence of local community spread during the outbreak of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19), and in an effort to respond quickly to prevent and alleviate the suffering of people exposed to and those infected with the virus, as well as those that could potentially be infected or impacted by COVID-19.

WHEREAS, the conditions necessitating declaration of a state of disaster continue to exist; and

WHEREAS, §418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code provides that a local state of disaster may not be continued for a period of excess of seven days without the consent of the governing body of the political subdivision;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PELICAN BAY, TEXAS:

1. That the Second Amended Declaration of Local Disaster Due to Public Health Emergency proclaimed for the City of Pelican Bay, Texas by the Mayor on March 26, 2020, shall continue until 4/15/2020 subject to further extension if deemed necessary by the City Council.
2. That the City's Emergency Management Plan shall continue to be implemented. Any violation of rules, regulations, or directives adopted pursuant to the Emergency Management Plan or the Declaration of Disaster shall be subject to the penalties set forth in the Emergency Management Plan.
