Updated July 2, 2020 -Tarrant County Public Health has advised the City that we have **three (3)** new cases of COVID-19 in Pelican Bay city limits in the last four (4) days. This brings the overall total of cases in Pelican Bay to eight (8) with five (5) being reported as recovered. The City has no further publicly releasable information on these individuals.
