

NOTICE OF A SPECIAL CALLED MEETING OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF PELICAN BAY

Notice is hereby given that a Special Called Meeting of the City Council of the City of Pelican Bay will be held on Monday, March 30, 2020 at 7:00 p.m., at which time the below listed agenda items will be discussed. All agenda items are subject to action.

This meeting will be closed to in-person attendance by the public. A temporary suspension of the Open Meetings Act to allow telephone or videoconference public meetings has been granted by Governor Greg Abbott. These actions are being taken to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 by avoiding meetings that bring people into a group setting and in accordance with Section 418.016 of the Texas Government Code. Telephonic/videoconferencing capabilities will be utilized to allow individuals to address the Council. Emails may also be submitted. Members of the public are entitled to participate remotely via Zoom Teleconferencing. An urgent public necessity exists requiring immediate action of the City Council due to an imminent threat to public health and safety arising from the COVID-19 pandemic. On March 18, 2020, the Governor of the State of Texas, issued the following proclamation:

“A proclamation suspending Sections 41.0052(a) and (b) of the Texas Election Code and Section 49.103 of the Texas Water Code to the extent necessary to allow political subdivisions that would otherwise hold elections on May 2, 2020, to move their general and special elections for 2020 only to the next uniform election date, occurring on November 3, 2020, without otherwise adjusting the term of office, and suspending Sections 31.093 and 42.0621(c) of the Texas Election Code to the extent necessary to require all county election officers, if requested by an affected political subdivision, to enter into a contract to furnish election services with any political subdivision who postponed their election to November 3, 2020, under the authority of this proclamation.”


