B. REVIEW, DISCUSSION, AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO APPROVE ORDINANCE #246 WHICH WOULD REPEAL ORDINANCE #212 AND SET FORTH NEW ANIMAL CONTROL REGULATIONS.

Alderman Sellers made a motion to approve Ordinance #246 which will repeal Ordinance #212 and set forth new animal control regulation. Alderman Long seconded the motion. Motion passed 4-0.

C. REVIEW, DISCUSSION, AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO APPROVE PROVIDING TEXAS MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT SYSTEM FOR EMPLOYEES.

Alderman Oberg made a motion to approve providing Texas Municipal Retirement System for employees at 5% City match with 100% prior service credit. The General Fund portion will be paid from the General Fund Reserve Account and the Utility portion will be part of their budget. Alderman Sellers seconded the motion. Motion passed 4-0.

Alderman Sellers made a motion to approve the proposed budget for public hearing.
Alderman Oberg seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-1 (Alderman Crawford was the NO vote.)
