



CITY COUNCIL MEETING RECAP – August 29, 2022

Here is a brief recap of some of Council's action items at the last City Council meeting:

- **Approved the budget for Fiscal Year 2022-2023.**

Within the new budget, Council approved to pursue a contract with Tarrant County Sheriff's Department for police and dispatch services. Tarrant County will absorb the current police department. Our current officers will be hired by Tarrant County and can be stationed at the Bay upon completion of training. Until Tarrant County can take over services, Mayor Olague stated that some scheduling changes have been made within the police department and effective this week the Bay will have some overnight coverage.

To Protect and Serve



- **Approved the ad valorem tax rate of \$0.753999 per \$100 of valuation on all taxable property.**

2021 tax rate was \$.800000 and 2022 tax rate will be \$0.753999.

- **Approved purchase of a used truck for Animal Control Services.**

Animal Control Services has outgrown the small Mazda pickup that has been used for the last ten years. Council approved the purchase of a bigger used vehicle up to \$16,000. Mayor Olague confirmed that there are funds available in the current budget for the purchase.
