



CITY COUNCIL MEETING RECAP – NOVEMBER 15, 2022

Here is a brief recap of some of Council's action items at the last City Council meeting:



Council approved hiring a part-time Animal Control/Ordinance Enforcement position. This person will work nights and weekends. Applications can be picked up at City Hall during regular business hours.

Approved a vendor agreement to partner with the City of Fort Worth for the Low Income Housing/Water Assistance Program and Texas Utility Help program. Now, residents who need assistance in paying their water bill can apply for these programs through their website.



The Mayor informed the Council that the Tarrant County Sheriff's Department cannot provide police coverage until October 2023. While Administration was disappointed in this news, the Mayor quickly sprang into action with a plan. With the recent resignation of Sergeant Wilson, the City is down to two officers. Chief Anderson has agreed to stay on along with Sergeant Zubiata and hire two additional police officers to replace Sergeant Wilson and Officer Barber, who is now with Saginaw PD.

Chief Anderson assured the Mayor that once the two new officers are officially sworn in, he will schedule appropriately to allow for police coverage at night and on the weekends.
