

ORDINANCE NO 1

AN ORDINANCE TO BE DESIGNATED AS THE TRAFFIC CODE FOR THE TOWN OF PELICAN BAY, TEXAS AMENDING ALL OTHER PROVISIONS OF ANY ORDINANCE IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; CONTAINING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE, A PENALTY CLAUSE AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF PELICAN BAY, TEXAS:

I.

The provisions of Article 6701d as amended and as hereinafter may be amended are hereby adopted and made the Traffic Code of the Town of Pelican Bay, Texas save and except those provisions, chapters and subsections set forth herein which are expressly excluded and not made a part of the Traffic Code of the Town of Pelican Bay, Texas. Apart from the exceptions noted herein, all of the provisions, sections and chapters of Article 6701d of Vernon's Annotated Civil Statutes of the State of Texas are expressly made the Traffic Code of the Town of Pelican Bay, Texas. The exceptions and exclusions of those portions of Article 6701d of Vernon's Annotated Civil Statutes are as follows:

Sections 9, Section 20d, Section 26, Section 28,  
Section 29, Section 30, Section 44b, Section 45,  
Section 46, Section 48, Section 49, Section 98,  
Section 105, Section 106, Section 108b, Section 132,  
Section 136, Section 137, Section 139, Section 139A,  
Section 140b, c, d, e, f, g, h, Section 141,  
Section 142, Article 18 in its entirety, Article 19  
in its entirety.

Except as to those sections which are expressly omitted and listed above all other provisions of Article 6701d shall and are now to be the Traffic Code for the Town of Pelican Bay, Texas.

II.

All future amendments made to Article 6701d and to those sections that are not excluded herefrom this ordinance shall be automatically a part of and become a part of the Traffic Code of the Town of Pelican Bay, Texas.

III.

All ordinances, or parts thereof in conflict with this ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict and only to the extent of such conflict. Except as to the extent of such conflict in repeal all prior ordinances are continued in full force and effect.

IV.

Should any section, clause or provision of this ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.

V.

Any person, firm or corporation that violates, disobeys, neglects or refuses to comply with, or that resists the enforcement of, any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) nor more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense. Each day that a violation is permitted to exist shall constitute a separate offense and shall be punishable as such.

The Town may also bring suit for injunction against any person, firm or corporation that shall violate or threaten to violate any of the provisions of this ordinance, in order to prevent a continued violation of such threatened violation.

VI.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and publication as required by law.
