

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE PLACE SYSTEM FOR THE TOWN OF PELICAN BAY, TEXAS; PROVIDING THAT AT THE FIRST MUNICIPAL ELECTION WHICH ARE TO BE HELD IN APRIL OF 1982, THE MAYOR AND ALDERPERSONS FOR PLACES 1 AND 2 AND THE TOWN MARSHALL SHALL BE ELECTED FOR A TERM OF TWO (2) YEARS, AND THEREAFTER, FOR A TERM OF TWO (2) YEARS; PROVIDING THAT ALDERPERSONS FOR PLACES 3, 4, AND 5, SHALL AT THE MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS BE ELECTED INITIALLY FOR A TERM OF ONE (1) YEAR AND THEREAFTER, THEIR SUCCESSORS ELECTED FOR A TERM OF TWO (2) YEARS TO CONTINUE IN SUCH MANNER THEREAFTER; CONTAINING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE, PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF TOWN OF PELICAN BAY, TEXAS:

I.

There is hereby established and created the Place System for all alderpersons serving on the Board of Aldermen for the Town of Pelican Bay, Texas:

From passage hereof, there is established the Place System for all alderpersons to be No. 1 through 5 consecutively. Candidates desiring to seek election to the office of alderperson, shall file and declare their intent to run for such places on the Board of Aldermen as may then be up for election.

II.

At the first general election for Mayor, Town Marshall, and Alderpersons, the following terms are hereby established and set forth:

- (a) Mayor Two Years
- (b) Town Marshall Two Years
- (c) Alderperson, Place One Two Years
- (d) Alderperson, Place Two Two Years
- (e) Alderperson, Place Three One Year
- (f) Alderperson, Place Four One Year
- (g) Alderperson, Place Five One Year

After the holding of the election as hereinabove prescribed and set forth during April, 1982, and at all subsequent municipal elections held for that purpose, the Mayor, Town Marshall, and all Alderpersons shall serve for a term of two years

and/or until their successor in office has been elected and qualified as such.

III.

Should any section, clause, or provision of this ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.

IV.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and publication as required by law.
