

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF PELICAN BAY,
TEXAS ADOPTING THE STATE OF TEXAS CONSTRUCTION STANDARDS FOR PRIVATE SEWAGE FACILITIES, 1977 EDITION, AND AS HEREINAFTER AMENDED; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Pelican Bay, Texas has determined that it is necessary to adopt a code to provide complete requirements for the installation and maintenance of sewage systems within the Town of Pelican Bay, Texas in order to provide for the protection of public health, safety and welfare;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PELICAN BAY, TEXAS:

I.

The State of Texas Construction Standards for Private Sewage Facilities, 1977 Edition, and as hereinafter amended, a copy of which is on file in the office of the Town Secretary of the Town of Pelican Bay, Texas, is hereby adopted and designated as the Sewage Disposal Code of the Town of Pelican Bay, Texas, the same as though such code were copied at length herein.

II.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance, and all of the remaining portions of this Ordinance not so held unconstitutional or invalid shall continue to be in full force and effect.

III.

Any person, firm, corporation, or any agent or employee thereof who violates any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C" Misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not to exceed TWO HUNDRED AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$200.) for each offense. Each day that a violation is permitted to exist shall constitute a separate offense.

IV.

The caption of this Ordinance stating in substance the purpose of this Ordinance and the penalty clause of this Ordinance shall be published one (1) time in a newspaper having general circulation in the Town of Pelican Bay, upon passage hereof. In addition, this Ordinance may be published in pamphlet form and shall be admissible in such form in any Court without further proof, as provided by law.

V.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
