

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE PROVISIONS OF TITLE 28 OF THE REVISED CIVIL STATUTES OF THE STATE OF TEXAS, AS AMENDED, AS THE SAME RELATES TO CITIES AND TOWNS; OUTLINING THE NECESSARY PREDICATE FOR DOING SO, AND PROVIDING FOR PASSAGE AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Pelican Bay, Texas, has now been in existence and incorporated as such for a period of almost one full year; and,

WHEREAS, the governing body has had ample opportunity to review the needs of the community, the problems associated with its growth and orderly development and its immediate and long-term goals; and,

WHEREAS, the Town of Pelican Bay does now contain far more than 600 inhabitants residing within its corporate boundaries; and,

WHEREAS, the adoption of the provisions relating to Title 28 of Vernon's Annotated Civil Statutes of the State of Texas, as amended, relating to Cities and Towns would serve the best interest of the inhabitants of Pelican Bay, and would better facilitate the management of its fiscal and all other affairs:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF PELICAN BAY, TEXAS:

I.

The provisions of Title 28 of Vernon's Annotated Revised Civil Statutes of the State of Texas, 1925, as amended, relating to cities and towns, is hereby adopted in full by the Board of Aldermen of the Town of Pelican Bay.

II.

Notice of this general meeting was duly posted in accordance with the law, and the consideration of this action was noted as an item on the agenda for this meeting.

III.

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
