

AN ORDINANCE ABOLISHING THE OFFICE OF MARSHAL OF THE CITY OF PELICAN BAY AND PROVIDING FOR THE DESIGNATION OF A CHIEF OF POLICE WITH SUCH ASSISTANTS AS DEEMED APPROPRIATE BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF PELICAN BAY AND TRANSFERRING THE RIGHTS, DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES PREVIOUSLY A PART OF THE OFFICE OF MARSHAL TO THE OFFICE OF POLICE CHIEF HEREBY ESTABLISHED UNDER AND BY VIRTUE OF THE TERMS OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF PELICAN BAY, TEXAS:

I.

Acting pursuant to Art. 999A, of Vernon's Annotated Civil Statutes, Chapter 3, of Title 28, of office of Town Marshal for the City of Pelican Bay, Texas, is abolished.

II.

The Board of Aldermen shall be authorized to appoint, hire, and designate a Police Chief to serve as the chief law enforcement officer for the City of Pelican Bay upon such conditions, and for such tenure and at such rate of pay as in the best judgment of the Board of Aldermen may be deemed appropriate. In keeping with the same, the Board of Aldermen shall also be entitled to select and appoint and hire such assistants to aid and assist the Chief of Police of the City of Pelican Bay in the performance of his duties as may be deemed appropriate at any given time.

III.

All previous rights, functions, obligations, and duties attendant to the office of Marshal are hereby transferred and conveyed over to the person occupying the designation of Chief of Police for the City of Pelican Bay.

This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage as provided by law.
