

AN ORDINANCE CALLING FOR THE HOLDING OF THE MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS FOR THE CITY OF PELICAN BAY, TEXAS, ON SATURDAY, APRIL 6, 1985, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING OFFICIALS TO SERVE AS MAYOR AND ALDERPERSONS PLACES 3, 4 AND 5, MAYOR BEING AN UNEXPIRED TERM OF ONE (1) YEAR, AND PLACES 3, 4, AND 5, BEING FOR A TERM OF TWO YEARS; DESIGNATING THE TIME AND PLACE OF SAID ELECTIONS; NAMING AND DESIGNATING THE JUDGE, ALTERNATE OR ASSISTANT JUDGE AND CLERKS TO SERVE IN SAID ELECTION; PROVIDING THAT THOSE ELECTED PERSONS NOW HOLDING SAID OFFICES CONTINUE TO DO SO UNTIL THEIR SUCCESSOR IN OFFICE HAS BEEN ELECTED AND QUALIFIED; DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO SIGN A NOTICE OF ELECTION AND PUBLISH THE SAME AS REQUIRED BY LAW; PROVIDING FOR ABSENTEE VOTING AND REQUIRING THE ELECTION JUDGE TO DELIVER THE CERTIFIED RESULTS OF THE ELECTION TO THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL AT THE NEXT REGULARLY SCHEDULED COUNCIL MEETING IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE HOLDING OF SAID ELECTION; AND PROVIDING FOR PASSAGE AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF PELICAN BAY, TEXAS:

I.

An election shall be held in the City of Pelican Bay, Texas on the 6th day of April, 1985, that begin the first Saturday in April of said year and the date of the regular city election as required by V.A.T.S.

The election shall be conducted from 7:00 A.M. until 7:00 P.M. in City Hall located at 1300 Pelican Circle, Pelican Bay, Texas.

II.

Voters at said election shall cast their ballots for the candidate of their choice to hold and occupy the office of Alderpersons Place 3, 4, and 5, for a term of two (2) years. Voters shall likewise cast their ballots for the candidate of their choice to serve and occupy the office of Mayor for a term of one (1) year, being an unexpired term.

III.

All persons so elected at the election above described shall hold, occupy and serve in said offices until their successors have been duly elected and/or appointed as provided by law and have qualified to serve in such office.

IV.

The Mayor is hereby directed and ordered to give notice of said election as required by law.

V.

Absentee voting shall be conducted beginning March 18 and ending April 2, 1985, at the office of the City Secretary which is located at 1300 Pelican Circle, Pelican Bay, Texas, from the hours of 8:00 A.M. until 5:00 P.M. during normal work days.

VI.

The following Judge, Assistant Judge and two (2) Clerks are hereby empowered, authorized and directed by the Board of Aldermen to hold and conduct said election according to law and to make return thereof to the Board of Aldermen at the regularly scheduled council meeting immediately following the holding of said election.
