

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A RATE INCREASE AND TARIFF PROPOSAL
OF PELICAN BAY UTILITY COMPANY, PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
DATE AND PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE

WHEREAS, Pelican Bay Utility Company has filed a Statement of Intent and Application to Increase Rates in the City of Pelican Bay, and


WHEREAS, on October 24, 1985, the City Council of the City of Pelican Bay considered the rate increase and proposed tariff revisions filed by Pelican Bay Utility Company; and

WHEREAS, after hearing, the City Council of the City of Pelican Bay has determined that the rate increase and proposed tariff revisions should be approved;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PELICAN BAY, TEXAS:

1. That the proposed rate increase of Pelican Bay Utility Company as filed with the City Secretary of the City of Pelican Bay, including the tariff revisions contained therein should be revised in accordance with the rate and tariff provisions attached hereto and hereby incorporated by reference in full herein, and should be and is hereby approved.
2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and it is so ordained.
3. Should any part, portion, section or part of a section of this Ordinance or the tariff attached hereto be declared invalid or inoperative or void for any reason, such decision, opinion or judgment shall in no way affect the remaining portions, parts, sections or parts of sections, which provisions shall be, remain and continue to be in full force and effect.
