

AN ORDINANCE CALLING FOR THE ADDITION TO THE MUNICIPAL ELECTION BALLOT OF A PROPOSAL OF A 1% CITY SALES TAX FOR THE CITY OF PELICAN BAY, TEXAS, TO BE HELD ON SATURDAY APRIL 5, 1986, VOTING FOR OR AGAINST SAID PROPOSAL, PROVIDING FOR THE CITY SECRETARY TO ADD SAID PROPOSAL TO THE BALLOT, PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLIC NOTICE OF SAID PROPOSAL AS REQUIRED BY LAW.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF PELICAN BAY, TEXAS:

I.

An election shall be held in the City of Pelican Bay, Texas, on Saturday, April 5, 1986, that being the first Saturday in April of said year, and the date of the regular city election as required by V.A.T.S. and shall have in addition to Mayor and Aldermen Places, a proposal of a 1% City Sales Tax.

II.

Voters at said election shall cast their ballot either for or against said proposed 1% City Sales Tax to be collected on all sales within the City Limits of the City of Pelican Bay, Texas.

III.

The City Secretary is hereby directed and ordered to have said proposal added to the Official Ballots of the City of Pelican Bay, Texas.

IV.

The City Secretary is also directed and ordered to give notice of said proposal to be published as required by law.
