

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE POSTING OR SIGNING OF STREET ADDRESS NUMBERS FOR DWELLINGS AND STRUCTURES; PROVIDING A SEVERANCE CLAUSE; PROVIDING A PENALTY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Pelican Bay, Texas, finds that the posting or signing of street address numbers visible from the street is in the interest of the public health and welfare for the ease of identification of homes and businesses in the City in emergency situations; and now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF PELICAN BAY, TEXAS:

I.

The street address number shall be required to be posted on all residential and commercial structures, mailboxes, and curbs pertaining thereto.

II.

That the street address number shall be visible from the street so that emergency vehicles will be able to locate and respond to the proper address in a timely manner.

III.

If any portion, sentence, clause, or section of this ordinance shall be declared illegal, unenforceable, or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, then such illegal, unenforceable, or unconstitutional portion shall not invalidate the remainder of this ordinance.


IV.

Any person, firm, or corporation who shall violate or cause or permit anyone to violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined not to exceed the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00). Each and every day that any violation of this ordinance or any part thereof shall occur shall be considered to be a separate and distinct offense and punishable as such.

V.

This ordinance shall become effective September 30, 1986.
