## **ORDINANCE NO. 236**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PELICAN BAY, TEXAS, TARRANT COUNTY, AMENDING THE PELICAN BAY SANITARY SEWER RATES.

WHEREAS, the City of Azle has increased the Wholesale Wastewater Treatment rates charged to the City of Pelican Bay; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is committed to maintaining utility rates adequate to provide for adequate debt service and operation expense coverage;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PELICAN BAY, TEXAS:

Section 1: Sanitary Sewer Rates.

The following monthly rates shall be in effect for all sanitary sewer system customers of the City of Pelican Bay:

Residential Customers: Residential customers' rates will be based on 85% of metered water consumed.

- 1. \$38.15 base rate (which includes the first 2,000 gallons of water used); plus
- 2. \$2.50 per 1,000 gallons for water used between 2,000 and 5,000 gallons; plus
- 3. \$3.00 per 1,000 gallons of water used between 5,000 and 12,000 gallons.
- 4. There is no additional charge for sewer for water consumed in excess of 12,000 gallons.

## Commercial Customers:

- 1. \$38.15 base rate (which includes the first 2,000 gallons of water used); plus
- 2. \$2.50 per 1,000 gallons for water used between 2,000 and 5,000 gallons; plus
- 3. \$3.00 per 1,000 gallons for water used over 5,000 gallons.
- Section 2: It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this ordinance are severable and, if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid by the final judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation in this ordinance of any such invalid phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.
- Section 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage.
