

**RESOLUTION NO. 269**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PELICAN BAY, TARRANT COUNTY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR GRANT #4323901, IN-CAR CAMERA UPGRADE PROJECT, OF THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE GRANT PROGRAM-FY2022 TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR. THIS RESOLUTION WILL REPLACE RESOLUTION NO. 265.**

**WHEREAS**, the Pelican Bay City Council (“City Council”) finds it in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Pelican Bay and its police officers that Grant #4323901, In-Car Camera Upgrade Project, of the Criminal Justice Grant Program-FY 2022 be operated for the 2022 year; and

**WHEREAS**, no matching funds for this project are required by the grant application; and

**WHEREAS**, City Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, the City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor, in full; and


**WHEREAS**, City Council designates the Mayor as the grantee’s authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council approves submission of the application for Grant #4323901, In-Car Camera Upgrade Project, of the Criminal Justice Grant Program-FY2022 to the Office of the Governor.


