## **RESOLUTION NO. 281**

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PELICAN BAY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING FUNDS FORMERLY COLLECTED FROM DONATIONS FROM RESIDENTS THROUGH THE UTILITY FUND FOR THE CITY OF PELICAN BAY FOOD PANTRY TO NOW BE DIVIDED EQUALLY BETWEEN ANIMAL CONTROL SERVICES AND FIRE SERVICES.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Pelican Bay, Texas currently receives a voluntary donation of \$5.00 per resident through the utility fund; and

**WHEREAS**, the voluntary donations are distributed between the City of Pelican Bay Food Pantry, Animal Control Services and Fire Services; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires the voluntary donations received be divided between Animal Control Services to help offset the cost of food, supplies, animal care, and/or equipment and Fire Protection Services to help offset the cost of providing fire protection and emergency services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PELICAN BAY, TEXAS:

**THAT,** the City Council of the City of Pelican Bay, Texas approves the acceptance of the \$5.00 voluntary donations from residents through the utility fund and appropriates the following amounts:

- 1. \$2.50 Animal Control Services
- 2. \$2.50 Fire Protection Services
