RESOLUTION NO. RES23-001

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PELICAN BAY, TEXAS ESTABLISHING A NUMBERING POLICY FOR ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS ENACTED BY THE CITY OF PELICAN BAY

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Pelican Bay is lawfully authorized to enact ordinances and resolutions to conduct business and govern the City of Pelican Bay; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that a new numbering system should be implemented for ordinances and resolutions to assist in the tracking of ordinances and resolutions;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PELICAN BAY, TEXAS:

THAT, the City Council of the City of Pelican Bay, Texas adopts the following Numbering Policy for ordinances and resolutions:

- 1. Ordinances shall be identified by the letters "ORD" followed by the last two numerals of the year, followed by a dash, followed by the sequential number of the ordinance; for example, the first ordinance of the year 2023 shall be labeled ORD23-001;
- 2. Resolutions shall be identified by the letters "RES" followed by the last two numerals of the year, followed by a dash, followed by the sequential number of the ordinance; for example, the first resolution of the year 2023 shall be labeled RES23-001;
- 3. Any City rules and regulations that contradict this policy are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
- 4. If any portion or provision in this policy is found by a court or administration agency to be unlawful, the unlawful provisions shall be constructively stricken, and the remaining portions shall be given full weight and effect.
- 5. This policy takes effect on January 1, 2023
